3359-26-07 Staff employee advisory committee.

- (A) The staff employee advisory committee, "SEAC," shall serve as an advisory body to the president. Matters involving collective bargaining shall not be referred to or addressed by the committee.
- (B) The full committee shall meet annually with the president. The executive officers meet with the president quarterly or as needed. Meeting minutes shall be made available for all full-time non-bargaining unistaff employees for review.
- (C) The committee shall call an annual meeting the first meeting following elections -

committee for an additional yearing appointment to complete a current assignment.

- (d) Each exofficio elected member will be evaluated annually at elections.
- (e) The remaining twelve elected/appointed **bargaining uni**tfull-time staff shall continue their staggered three ar terms.
- (F) Election.
 - (1) The "SEAC" shall establish election procedures. Such procedures shall call for nominations from th<u>eull-time non-bargaining</u>staff employees, which shall be sent to all members at least one week(s) three wpeibs to the elections. Ea<u>chll-time</u> non-bargainingstaff employee may submit for nomination the name of one nonbargainingfull-time staff employee. Selforminations are not permitted, and the nominees shallhdicate a willingness to serve.
 - (2) Ballots shall carry the names of all eligible persons who have been proposed for nomination. The person or persons receiving the largest number of votes shall fill the open position(s) in decreasing order of those votes, provided those persons are
